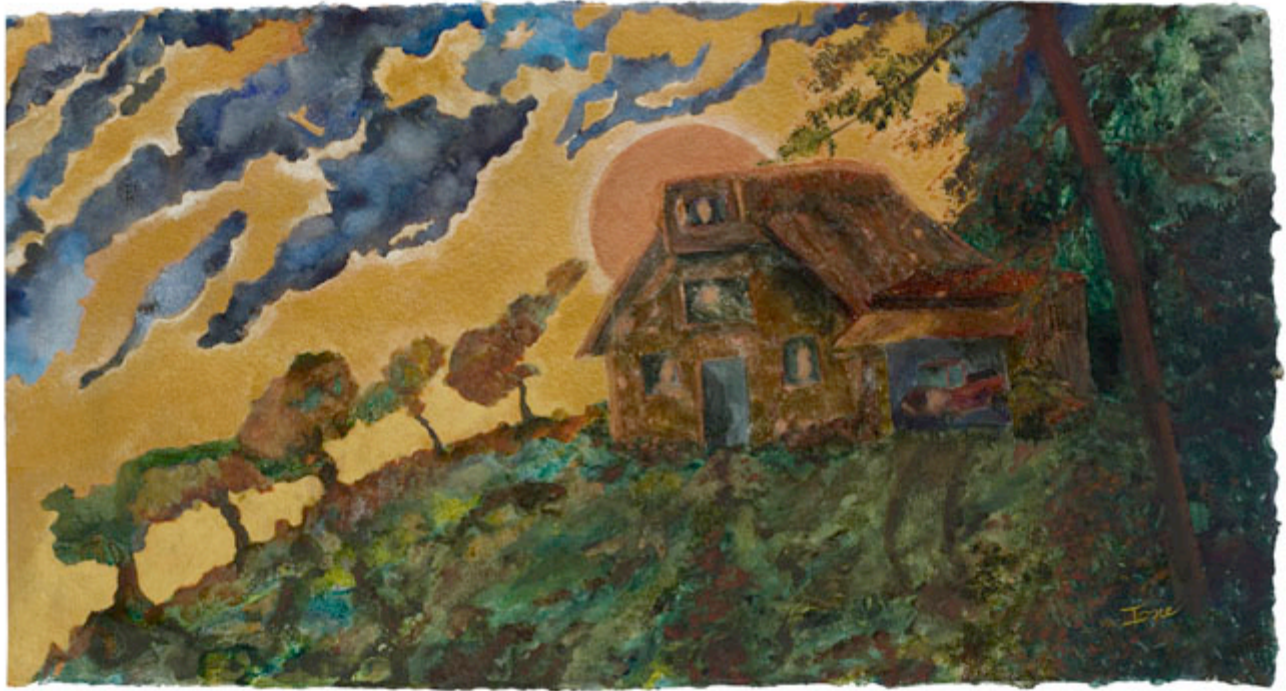

ARTIST'S STATEMENT

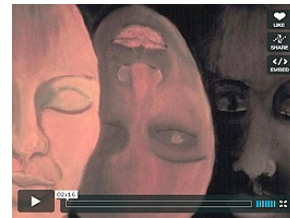
*I create art because I must.
